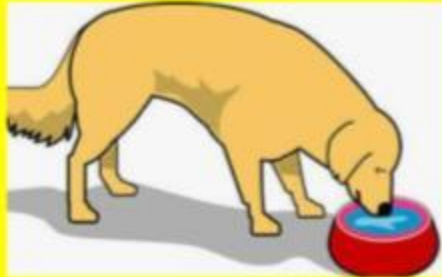


Animal Needs:

Animal Needs Vocabulary

Nutrients - A substance (material) that provides nourishment for growth and making energy.

Food- A substance (material) a living thing can take in to get energy and to help it grow.

Hunger - A feeling you get when you need food.

Habitat - The natural home or environment of an animal/human.

Animal - A living creature that feeds on natural resources.

Diet - The kinds of food a person/animal eat repeatedly.

Needs - Things necessary to live.

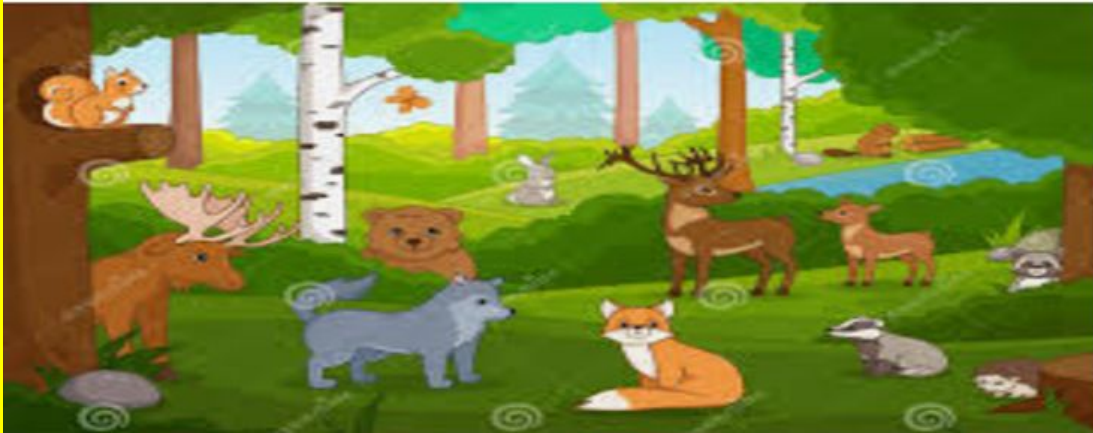
